

Schools in Guatemala

The Guatemala Government provides teachers for the local schools. However, families of students are required to pay certain school fees, uniforms, school supplies, such as pencils, pens, paper, notebooks, and books etc. Our Student Scholarship fund is used for students K through University who are unable to attend school because their families cannot afford to pay these school expenses. Scholarships are given to children who live in the area where the "Guatemala Mission Project" has completed service projects; such as installing fuel efficient stoves and various building projects. Students in need of scholarships are identified by their teachers or School Directors. Parents can also contact a Guatemala Project representative regarding a students need. The local Guatemala Project Director meets with the parents and students at the beginning of the school year to discuss their parental and student commitments to ensure school attendance and money usage for school expenses. Scholarship money is dispersed on a monthly basis to ensure the family and students are following through with their commitments.
